Science Spotlight

New Federal Cannabis Research Resource Center Announced!

At this year's [International Conference on the Science of Botanicals](#), a major step forward for cannabis science was unveiled: the [launch](#) of a federally funded **Resource Center for Cannabis and Cannabinoid Research (R3CR)**. Backed by leading institutions and federal collaboration from the National Institutes of Health (NIH), R3CR is designed to streamline research, fast-track regulatory clarity, and fuel innovation in cannabis-based medicine.

The center will include three cores:

- **Research Support Core**, led by Dr. Mary Paine of Washington State University (WSU): Offers scientific and regulatory information, hosts workshops, and awards seed grants to cannabis researchers.
- **Research Standards Core**, led by Dr. Nandu Sarma of the U.S. Pharmacopeia (USP): Develops and shares best practices and technical guidance for analytical procedures for investigational research and quality standards for cannabis studies.

- **Regulatory Guidance Core**, led by Dr. Mahmoud ElSohly of Ole Miss: Provides practical guidance to researchers navigating complex DEA and FDA regulations.
